Basic Pistol and CCW Class

This course is an introduction to pistol shooting and satisfies the training requirements of the State of Ohio to obtain a Concealed Handgun License.

Students will receive certified training in the following matters:

- **The ability to name, explain, and demonstrate the rules for safe handling of a handgun and proper storage practices for handguns and ammunition;**
- **The ability to demonstrate and explain how to handle ammunition in a safe manner;**
- **The ability to demonstrate the knowledge, skills, and attitude necessary to shoot a handgun in a safe manner;**
- **Gun-handling training.**
- **Additionally, students will receive two hours of in-person training, including range time and live-fire experience.**

Students will complete a written examination that tests their competency. Students will also physically demonstrate their competency on handgun usage and rules for safe handling.

Pistol Matches -Three Stage (Non Sanctioned) National Match Course

- First Stage – 50 Yards Slow Fire – One Series of 10 Shots, 10 Minutes
- Second Stage – 25 Yards Timed Fire – Two Series of 5 Shots, 20 Seconds Per Series
- Third Stage – 25 Yards Rapid Fire – Two Series of 5 Shots, 10 Seconds Per Series

Rimfire or Center Fire (Shooter's Choice) - Open Sights, Scopes, Red Dots

Shooters Must Provide Eye and Ear Protection and 30 Rounds of Ammo Per Relay

Empty Chamber Indicators (ECI's) Are Mandatory

100 Yard Rimfire Benchrest Match - Modified Rimfire Benchrest Rules

- First Stage – 10 Minutes, Unlimited Sighters
- Second Stage – Two Series of 10 Shots, 10 Minutes Per Series For Score

Front Rests May Be Either Sandbags or Bipods - Rear Rests May Be Sandbags Only

Front And Rear Rests (If Used) May Not Be Attached (No Sleds)

Sporter Class Rifles Only: Cannot Exceed 7 ½ Pounds (Including Scope),

Trigger Pull No Less Than 3 Pounds Open Sights, Scopes (6X Max.), Red Dots

Shooters Must Provide Eye and Ear Protection and 20 Rounds of Ammo (Plus Sighters) Per Relay

Empty Chamber Indicators (ECI's) Are Mandatory

Any Rifle Chambered for .22 Short, Long or Long Rifle Will Be Allowed

Match Rules and Equipment

Pistol Matches -Three Stage (Non Sanctioned) National Match Course

- First Stage – 50 Yards Slow Fire – One Series of 10 Shots, 10 Minutes
- Second Stage – 25 Yards Timed Fire – Two Series of 5 Shots, 20 Seconds Per Series
- Third Stage – 25 Yards Rapid Fire – Two Series of 5 Shots, 10 Seconds Per Series

**Rimfire or Center Fire (Shooter's Choice) - Open Sights, Scopes, Red Dots
Shooters Must Provide Eye and Ear Protection and 30 Rounds of Ammo Per
Relay**

Empty Chamber Indicators (ECI's) Are Mandatory

Rimfire Sporter Matches

Standard .22 LR caliber rimfire sporter type rifles not exceeding 7.5 lbs (including optics). Trigger weight of not less than 3 pounds. Telescopic or open sights may be used. Telescopic sights are limited to maximum 6X power. Leather or web slings, not wider than 1 ¼", may be used in prone and sitting (or kneeling) positions. Additional equipment may include shooting mat (recommended), work-style glove for support hand, and spotting scopes. No thumbhole stocks, banana magazines, cheek pieces, adjustable butt plates, rails, or adjustable sling swivels are allowed. You may use only .22 LR ammo, absolutely no magnum rounds are allowed.

Shooters Must Provide Eye and Ear Protection and 60 Rounds of Ammo (Plus Sighters) Per Relay

Empty Chamber Indicators (ECI's) Are Mandatory

Course:

- Sighting Stage – Unlimited Shots, prone position, 10 minute time limit
- Stage 1: Prone Position, 10 Shots, 10 Minute Time Limit, Slow Fire 50 Yards
- Stage 2: From a Standing to Prone Position, 10 Shots, Two 5 Shot Strings, 5 Shots Per String, Rapid Fire 50 Yards
- Stage 3: From a Standing to Sitting or Kneeling Position, 10 Shots, 10 Minute Time Limit, Slow Fire 50 Yards
- Stage 4: Standing to Sitting or Kneeling Position, 10 Shots, Two 5 Shot Strings, 5 Shots Per String, Rapid Fire 50 Yards
- Stage 5: Standing Position, 10 Shots, 10 Minute Time Limit, Slow Fire 25 Yards
- Stage 6: Standing Position (Starting with butt of rifle on hip), 10 Shots, Two 5 Shot Strings, 5 Shots Per String, Rapid Fire 25 Yards

Semi-automatic rifles are allowed 25 seconds for rapid fire strings

Bolt action, manually operated rifles, are allowed 30 seconds for rapid fire strings
