GENERAL RANGE RULES

All members are to make themselves familiar with all range rules and by-laws governing the use of the club facilities. No excuse for lack of knowledge will be accepted as failure to follow these requirements:

1. MEMBERS MUST SIGN IN AND OUT EACH TIME THEY ENTER AND LEAVE THE CLUB GROUNDS. THE MEMBER MUST LIST HIS/HER NAME, KEY FOB NUMBER, DATE, TIME IN, AND TIME OUT. THE SIGN-IN MUST OCCUR BEFORE USING ANY CLUB FACILITIES. NAMES OF GUESTS MUST ALSO BE ENTERED ON THE REGISTER AND GUESTS MUST SIGN IN TO RELEASE ORCO OF LIABILITY AND THE GUEST RANGE FEE BE DEPOSITED IN THE PAYMENT BOX.
2. LIMIT YOUR GUESTS TO TWO (2) AT ONE TIME. YOU MUST REVIEW RANGE RULES WITH YOUR GUEST(S), AND BE WITH YOUR GUEST(S). YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR ACTIONS. DO NOT LEND OR GIVE OUT YOUR KEY FOB, IT IS CLUB PROPERTY.
3. ALL SHOOTERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR CLEANING UP AFTER THEMSELVES. THIS INCLUDES BEHIND THE FIRING LINE, IN FRONT OF THE FIRING LINE, AND ALSO THE CLUB HOUSE AREA. CLEAN UP ANY AND ALL AREAS USED.
4. PLACE FIRED BRASS AND ONLY FIRED BRASS (**NO ALUMINUM OR STEEL**) INTO THE BRASS BARREL. BE CAREFUL THAT NO TRASH OR GARBAGE IS THROWN INTO THE BRASS BARREL.
5. TURN OFF ALL OF THE LIGHTS AND MAKE SURE THE DOOR IS CLOSED AND LOCKED WHEN LEAVING.
6. NO MEMBER, UNLESS A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER OR APPROPRIATELY LICENSED INDIVIDUAL, MAY CARRY A CONCEALED FIREARM ON THE CLUB PROPERTY. LOADED FIREARMS ARE NOT TO BE HANDLED EXCEPT AT THE FIRING POINTS ON ALL CLUB PROPERTY. ALL SAFETY AND RANGE RULES MUST BE FOLLOWED.
7. THE RANGE(S) MAY BE CLOSED ON OCCASION FOR WORK PARTIES, LAW ENFORCEMENT TRAINING, MATCHES, AND OTHER TRAINING COURSES OR PROGRAMS. ALL REQUESTS TO CLOSE THE RANGE FOR SUCH PURPOSES MUST BE CLEARED THROUGH THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER / EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE.
8. NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES MAY BE SERVED OR CONSUMED ON ANY PART OF THE ORCO CLUB PROPERTY AT ANY TIME.
9. NO MEMBER SHALL PERFORM OR ATTEMPT TO PERFORM ANY MAINTENANCE, REPAIRS, IMPROVEMENTS OR MODIFICATIONS OF ANY KIND TO CLUB FACILITIES WITHOUT PRIOR APPROVAL OF THE BOARD.

GENERAL RANGE RULES

10. RANGE DAMAGE RULE

- a. IF A MEMBER OR THEIR GUEST(S) CAUSE DAMAGE TO ORCO FACILITIES AND THE MEMBER SELF-REPORTS THE DAMAGE; THEY WILL BE CHARGED FOR THE COST OF REPAIRS. THEY MAY PERFORM THE REPAIRS UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF A BOARD MEMBER IF IT IS WITHIN THEIR SKILL SET. EXCESSIVE OCCURRENCES OF SELF-REPORTED DAMAGE MAY BE DEALT WITH AT THE DISCRETION OF THE BOARD.
- b. IF A MEMBER OR THEIR GUEST(S) CAUSE DAMAGE TO ORCO FACILITIES AND THE MEMBER DOES NOT SELF-REPORT IT BUT IS CAUGHT ON VIDEO, IS REPORTED BY ANOTHER MEMBER, OR OTHERWISE DISCOVERED, THEY WILL ON THEIR FIRST OFFENCE BE CHARGED FOR THE COST OF REPAIRS, AND CHARGED A FINE OF \$25.

THE SECOND OFFENCE THEY WILL BE CHARGED FOR THE COST OF REPAIRS, FINED \$50, AND MAY BE SUSPENDED FOR 3 MONTHS.

THE THIRD OFFENCE THEY MAY BE EXPELLED AND WILL HAVE THEIR NAME PUBLISHED IN THE NEWS LETTER.

- c. WE ARE REQUIRED TO REPORT SUSPENSIONS AND EXPULSIONS TO THE NRA PER OUR BY-LAWS.
11. FOR ANY SAFETY RULE INFRACTION OR OTHER PROBLEMS, NOTIFY THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE AS SOON AS POSSIBLE. RUN THE KEY ACCESS FOB A FEW TIMES THROUGH THE SCANNER TO PINPOINT THE DATE AND TIME OF THE VIOLATION OR PROBLEM.
12. NO TITLE II FIREARMS ARE ALLOWED WITH THE EXCEPTION OF LICENSED AND LEGALLY OWNED SUPPRESSORS AND SHORT BARRELED RIFLES AND SHOTGUNS.
- a. OWNERS OF SUCH ITEMS SHALL HAVE THEIR REGISTRATION DOCUMENT READILY AVAILABLE FOR INSPECTION.
 - b. NO FIREARM CHAMBERED FOR THE .50 BMG ROUND MAY BE USED.
 - c. NO FIREARMS CAPABLE OF FULLY AUTOMATIC OR BURST FIRE ARE PERMITTED.
 - d. NO BUMP STOCK, BUMP FIRE, OR BINARY TRIGGERS ARE PERMITTED.
13. RANGE RULES MAY BE TEMPORARILY AMENDED OR MODIFIED FOR A MATCH, EVENT, TRAINING, ETC. WITH PRIOR APPROVAL FROM THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER OR HIS DESIGNEE.
