Garands are not bolt action guns and pounding the operating rods of club guns with higher than 175's is not safe. If in doubt? PLEASE CALL and Safe Match Data books and web information reference will be provided. Load Example: $30-06 \rightarrow Accurate$ wieghed 47.0 grains of IMR 4895 pushing a 168 grain Sierra MK with win. or rem. Primers in full length sized Match/Military cases is the standard 30-06 match load.

If you are using the AR-15 black rifle? Please make sure your primers are slamfire resistant CCI 400's, Federal AR type, or Remington 7 1/2 BR. Any 50 to 77 grain .223 bullet wieght that will chamber and fit in magazines may be used.

YOU DO NOT OWN A GARAND or other military rifle? 8 CLUB Garands will be available for use. Students/competitors MAY use their own rifle & will need a typical safety and compliance inspection. A failed rifle will just mean you will have to use a club rifle. *Match grade rifles MAY be used, but you will not be eligible for rack awards. You may also use your Springfield or M1 Carbine or even M1A. Just note that we will only have ammo 30-06 ammo for purchase.
