Prez sez:

The outdoor pistol range is nearly finished. Our current plan is NOT to install 2" pipes in the ground at the 25 and 50 yard or 50 meter lines. The reason is twofold. First, the pipes shift, sink, fill with dirt & other debris and become unusable without constant maintenance. Second, the board decided that people should be able to shoot at distances other than 25 and 50 yards or 50 meters. We will be testing target stands with movable bases and will provide target stands when a suitable design is accepted. Initially we will provide 3 stands for testing designed by Bob Fultz. In the meantime there is an older acceptable design available on the web site at:

We are planning to install PVC markers on both sides of the range near the berms to mark 25 yards, 50 yards and 50 meters. This will allow you to approximate your target placement at these distances. For outdoor Bullseye, PPC or other matches, the match officer will mark the distance with string stretched between the PVC markers or with soluble paint. You may bring a string of the length (distance) you want to shoot and place you target at that distance. Please take the string with you when you leave so it doesn't tangle in the mower.

IMPORTANT – When you place your target and stand, **MAKE SURE THAT YOUR BULLETS WILL SAFELY IMPACT THE BACKSTOP**. Failure to do so will constitute a safety violation and may result in disciplinary action. Bring a piece of 2 foot wide cardboard to attach to the uprights. DO NOT hang targets with the scoring rings in front of the wooden uprights and destroy them. DO NOT intentionally shoot at the side berms. DO NOT shoot at rocks or anything that might cause a ricochet. Have fun on the new range but use common sense and ALWAYS think safety first.

DUTY-GUN MATCHES

Matches will be run on <u>Wednesday</u> evenings. Set-up at 5:30 PM and shooting to commence immediately afterward.

The course of fire is the standard 48 round duty-gun match. Barrel lengths up to 6 inches for revolvers will be allowed.

Two matches may be shot per night, however make-ups and shoot-aheads are allowed. The cost per match is \$4.00 for members & \$5.00 for non-members.

Matches will be held:

November 7, 14 December 5, 12, 19 January 2, 9, 16, 23, 30 February 6, 13, 20, 27 March 6, 13, 20, 27 April 3, 10, 17, 24

Trophies will be awarded. You must shoot <u>a total of 24 matches to qualify</u> for the awards and the dinner.

Rankings and Awards will be according to the Lewis System. Only the shooter's top 12 matches in each class will count toward awards.
